*Educators awarded at temporary levels must move to a higher level within two (2) years to retain eligibility. Deadlines may be reestablished at each temporary level. Family child care providers shall have three (3) years to achieve the education needed to move up.

**Yearly supplements are divided into two (2) installments; one installment paid every six months spent consistently working with children. Supplement amounts listed are based on working full time with children ages 0-5.
