SCRIPTURE - THE WRITTEN WORD OF GOD - THE BIBLE

The absolute main way He communicates to us. We must be good consistent students of the written word of God if we are to grow in our prophetic gifting. If do not know ABOUT Him, how can we speak FOR him.

STILL SMALL VOICE

The most regular way of Him communicating to us seems to cut across our own thoughts, or even can seem to us like it's our own thoughts, but it's His whisper. Easy to miss.

VISION

Can be still or moving. Can be in your mind's eye eg if I say chocolate, you are now seeing it in your mind's eye. Can also be immersive in the sense that you go into the vision.

OTHER PEOPLE

We sometimes miss this one. Maybe we have been praying and He has answered, maybe even through people that don't know Him. Maybe we don't believe he can do that. But He can. And He does.

ANGELS

PHRASE OR SENTENCE THAT LINGERS

Maybe it's from a film, or something you read or something someone says. or an advert or a poster. It's like suddenly that phrase comes back and doesn't go away. Pay attention to these moments. It could be Him.

SMELL, TASTE, TOUCH

We may not have thought of this, but these natural senses can be used powerfully by heaven. He can give us smell, a taste, a feeling in order to give us a message.

It can seem a bit unusual but these are ways that the Bible talks about so it is good we are aware. For some it may even be the primary way He communicates to them.

PUNS OR WORD PLAY

It may surprise you but our Father loves puns and word play. He has a brilliant sense of humour and loves to laugh. He loves to make us laugh because He knows it does us good.

He takes something like a person's name, or a place name or similar and makes it a message. The Bible is full of this. See if you can find some places where it happens.
