Be friendly and normal

Help people to relax

People coming in front of us may be even more nervous than you! They have been brave to be willing to let you speak to them. Do what you can to quickly make them feel at ease. Be normal and smile.



Remember TEAM

Build on a theme

Work as a team. If you have something similar, build on that before moving to the next theme. It's more helpful for the person receiving the word to process what He is saying to them. If there is time, you may be asked if you have any more to say.



Don't be put off by their expressions!

People react in different ways

Some people frown, some smile, others are poker faced. Some may cry as you speak. But try to avoid being guided by people's facial expressions or body language as you speak.



Try to smile...

..and don't apologise for being there

You are there because God wanted you there. It is not a mistake you are there. The enemy may try to lie to you that you are useless. It's just mind games. Don't say sorry for being there in your mind. Be confident and smile.



Be concise Don't repeat

It will be recorded!

The words will be recorded so please don't repeat yourself. It is not needed. Be as concise as you can while still delivering what He has given you. Please give room for others to say what they sense too. Use everyday language, avoid jargon. Avoid slipping into counselling or pastoring mode, even if you are skilled.

**Breathe. Be at rest.
It's not about you.
It's about that
person and Him.**

through you. You will be
