KS2 Average Scale Scores

National curriculum tests at the end of key stage 2 (KS2) (often referred to as SATs) are administered in mathematics, English reading and English grammar, punctuation and spelling. Writing is teacher assessed. Scaled scores are used to report the result of the tests and these are based on a pupil's raw score. The raw score is the total number of marks a pupil scores in a test, based on the number of questions they answered correctly. The range for scaled scores is: 80 – 120 marks. 100, is a pass, 110 is considered a high score indicating that the 'higher standard' has been attained.
