ATHLETIC AGREEMENT

I realize it is a privilege to participate in all athletic activities at Bethel Christian School ("BCS"). Accordingly, I agree to obey the following regulations and rules set forth by the Bethel Athletic Department.

General Information:

1. All athletes must have parental consent and a preparticipation sports physical ("PPE") before participating in tryouts or sports.
2. Sports packets are due at tryouts for the **first** sport played and retained for the rest of the year.
3. Sports fee (\$130.00) to be paid when due. Students will not be allowed to participate unless fees are fully paid. Charges will be applied to FACTS account; cash and checks can be brought to the main office.
4. All athletes must pay for lost or damaged equipment or jerseys.
5. All athletes must attend school on the day of a game/match or will not be allowed to participate.
6. Students who are sent home due to sickness or poor behavior will not be allowed to participate that day. Students who serve a detention are ineligible to play or practice that day. Students who are suspended or expelled will be removed from the team immediately.
7. All athletes are expected to attend practices and games unless absent due to illness or emergency. If a student is injured, but can attend school, he or she will also attend all games to support his/her team. A coach must be notified as soon as possible if a practice or game is to be missed.
8. All athletes must arrive and be picked up on time for games and practices; if not, students may be removed from the team.
9. There is no guarantee that every athlete will participate in every game. Coaches maintain discretion on play time and positions.
10. Athletes should remember that they represent Bethel Christian School at all times. They should have a Christian attitude by respecting officials, coaches, faculty, facilities, and other players. This is on and off the playing field. Athletes will follow all rules, regulations, and policies in the BCS Student Handbook.
11. Once team selections are made, athletes should be committed to the team for the entire season. If athletes quit before two weeks into the season, they can be refunded 25%; however, after the second week, there will be no refunds.
12. Athletes must abide by all team rules. Students may be removed from the team for attitude, behavior, or academic failure.

Eligibility:

1. Students can try out for a team if they do not have any F's on their Report card, have at least a 2.0 GPA, and have not received an "F" on their progress reports. If students drop to an F in any class, they will become ineligible for one week and/or until the grade is improved. Weekly grade checks are done while the student is in a sport.
2. Students suspended from school cannot continue playing during that particular season. They may try out for another sport in the same school year.
3. Students scheduled to serve a detention on the day of a game or practice will not be allowed to attend the game or practice. No exceptions.
