

The Nordic College of Caring Science Research Fund (NCCSF) is proud to announce the following grants:

a) RESEARCH GRANT of SEK 50 000

Criteria for the award of research grant:

- The project must adhere to the goals of NCCS and the statutes of the NCCSF (www.nccsweb.nu).
- The project description should be of good quality, and the board will assess the scientific quality.
- The board can decide to award the whole or part of the sum applied for by the applicant.
- Depending on the economic situation of the fund; one or more grants will be awarded.
- Grants must be utilized in the current or the year following the award.
- The grant, partially or entirely, must be reimbursed to the NCCSF if the recipient does not follow the approved plan as stated in the application.

The research grant can be applied for once a year. Deadline: 31.October

b) TRAVEL GRANT of SEK 15 000

Criteria for the award of travel grants:

- The grant can be used for participation in research conferences/congresses with oral or poster presentation of research in line with the goals of NCCS and the statutes of the NCCSF (www.nccsweb.nu).
- The grant can be used for participation in workshops.
- Conference/congress program must be attached to the application.
- The research description/abstract should be of good quality, and the board will assess the scientific quality.
- Confirmation of accepted abstract should be attached to the application.
- Grants must be utilized in the current or the year following the award.
- Travel grants are paid to the recipient after participation has been documented and receipts have been submitted in the Reporting form.

The travel grant can be applied for twice a year. Deadlines: 31. May and 31. October

For both grants, the following guidelines apply:

- Budget for the grant application must be attached. Any funds from other sources must be accounted for in the budget.
- Applications are evaluated by the NCCSF board. An explicit link to caring science is expected.
- The applicant must be a documented member of NCCS at the time of grant disbursement.
- Only one grant can be awarded per calendar year to a member (this includes both travel and research grants).
- Rejection cannot be appealed.
- The grants entail reporting obligations after the funds have been used. Original receipts must be attached during reporting.
- Awarded grants will be announced at the NCCS annual meeting and/or annual conference.
- Grants are awarded based on availability of funds within the NCCSF budget.
- Although the application text is in English, the application may be written in a Scandinavian language.
