Application deadline: September 26, 2025

Duration of the role: October 2025 to June 2026

- Become part of a dynamic team that is passionately committed to sustainability issues at the four universities in Bern.
- Gain insight into how sustainable development issues are promoted at the University of Bern and at the Bern university location.
- Network regularly beyond Bern in the GreENLIGHT network of the ENLIGHT Alliance with other students, both online and in person at an ENLIGHT partner university.
- Help shape the student sustainability community in Bern in various formats such as pitches in courses, small or medium-sized events, online campaigns, or your own ideas.
- Flexible time management for your commitment
- Proof of your commitment for your CV

- Scholarship for the duration of the role (HS25 /FS26)
