Observation Questions

- What did God instruct Hosea to do, and why? (Hosea 1:2-3)
- What were the names of Hosea's children, and what did they signify? (Hosea 1:4-9)
- What emotions does God express toward Israel in Hosea 11:8-9?
- According to Romans 12:1-2, what kind of sacrifice is pleasing to God?

Interpretation Questions

- What does Gomer's repeated betrayal represent in the context of Israel's relationship with God?
- How does God's response to Israel's unfaithfulness differ from human instinct?
- Why is revival impossible without repentance, according to Pastor Justin?
- In what ways does the wilderness serve as a place of purification and realignment?

Application Questions

- Have you made God the forgotten Father by turning to Him only when convenient?
- What is your personal "Egypt" — a place of past bondage you romanticize when the present feels hard?
- Are you chasing "wind" — unfulfilling goals, people, or status — instead of depending on the Father?
- What blessings in your life may have quietly become idols?
- Do you go to God as a Father or treat Him like a genie?
