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John 13: 34-35

### Observation Questions

- What command does Jesus give in John 13:34?
- According to verse 35, how will the world recognize true disciples?
- What example does Jesus set in John 13:12-17 before giving this command?
- What does Jesus say is the outcome of following His example (v.17)?

### Interpretation Questions

- How is Jesus' love different from what the world calls love?
- Why do selfishness and loving like Jesus not align?
- Why is Jesus' act of washing feet significant in the cultural and spiritual context?
- What does it reveal about His expectations for us?
- In what ways might "busyness" actually be a form of idolatry?
- How does placing Jesus first reorder everything else?

### Application Questions

- Where do you see selfishness quietly influencing your decisions or attitudes?
- What specific act of service is God prompting you to do this week—even if it's inconvenient?
- Look at your weekly schedule: What's one thing you need to reorder or release so Jesus is truly first?
- Who in your life right now needs to experience the love of Jesus through your service?
- Have you been avoiding community or accountability out of comfort? What's your next step toward change?
- What's one way you can imitate Jesus' humility this week—especially in a relationship or situation where you feel entitled?

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
