MATTHEW 6:7-18 NLT | ACTS 13:1-12 NLT

Discussion

- 1. How does praying "your will be done" and "give us... forgive us" confront the tendency toward self-focused prayer? What shifts when prayer becomes Kingdom- and community-minded?
- 2. The sermon argued that diversity without division is sustained by worship, prayer, and fasting. What tensions arise in diverse communities, and how do these practices re-center us?
- 3. Pastor Lee shared about church hurt and still choosing to love Christ's bride and intercede for pastors. What does this teach about perseverance, forgiveness, and healthy boundaries?
- 4. The message defined revival not as extended singing but as transformed living (love for those unlike us, unity, mission). Do you agree? Why or why not?

Application

- 1. Private before public: Choose one daily private practice for 7 days (e.g., pray the Lord's Prayer slowly, then personalize each line). What time/place will you commit to?
- 2.Intercede, don't just advise: Identify one person who's been "much-telling" a problem to you. Pause with them and pray on the spot this week, inviting Jesus into it.
- 3.Unity in diversity: Name one relationship in your church that needs unity. Take one step: pray for them daily, initiate a peacemaking conversation, or serve them anonymously.
- 4. Fast for clarity: Pick one simple fast (meal, media, or sweets) for a set window this week. Pair it with a focused question for the Holy Spirit (e.g., "Where do you want me to serve?"). Record any guidance you sense.
