Observation Questions

1. What situation were the four lepers facing outside the city gate? (2 Kings 7:3-4)
2. What miracle had God already worked in the Aramean camp before the lepers arrived? (v.5-7)
3. What did the lepers do once they discovered the abandoned camp? (v.8-9)
4. What prophecy did Elisha give at the beginning of the chapter? (v.1)
5. What was the outcome for the king's officer who doubted God's promise? (v.17-20)

Interpretation Questions

1. Why is the lepers' willingness to move so significant in the context of faith?
2. What does the story reveal about God's ability to work miracles through unexpected people?
3. How does the response of the officer contrast with the lepers' faith?
4. What does this passage teach us about the relationship between motion and miracles?
5. How does this story reflect God's desire not only to bless us, but to bless through us?

Application Questions

1. Where in your life are you tempted to "stay" instead of stepping out in faith?
2. What issue in your life might God be using as an opportunity for a miracle, rather than an obstacle?
3. Are you trusting more in what you see or in what God has said?
4. Who needs to hear the good news from your life that you've been keeping to yourself?
5. What step of faith do you need to take before this year ends so that something doesn't "die" in your life?
