#### **Mandatory Online Registration and Payment**

The DuPage Black Bears use Bond Sports forall registrations and payments. Newfamilies will need to create a login and password with Bond Sports prior to registering for the 2025 - 26 season. **All** members are required to register and pay online before attending any of the Black Bear on-ice events, such as preseason training, tryouts, and MOST IMPORTANTLY, before team placement. Payments will only be accepted online with a credit card or ACH payment.

# USA Hockey Registration for all8U, 10U, 12U, & 14U DuPage Black BearsPlayers

Allparticipants are required to purchase their 2025-26 season USAHockey insurancedirectly from USA Hockey **before** registering in the DuPage Black Bear system or attending any on-ice event. You will need your new USA confirmation number to register for any fall activities. #### **AAU Hockey Registration for 8U CUHL Travel Players ONLY**

IMPORTANT: Amateur AthleticUnion (AAU) after August15th, registration with AAU all teams, players, and coaches wishing to participate in AAU-sanctioned leagues, tournaments, and events must be current AAU members prior to taking part in any sanctioned competition.

#### **AAU Registration Instructions**

Visit aausports.org and clickthe"Join AAU"button. If you don't have anAAU account, select "Create Account." Choose "New Membership" if you're a first-time member, or "Renew Membership" if you're a returning member (we recommend Extended AB coverage). Fill out the required information and associate your registration with the DuPage Jr. Black Bears Club. Our club number will be available when AAU registration starts on 8/15/2025, and you can link your membership then or after completing your 2025-26 registration. Complete the checkout process. If you save progress without finishing, return by selecting "Go to My Account" to preserve your entries.

### **League Participation**

The DuPage Black Bears will compete in the following leagues for the 2025-2026 season: the DuPage Black Bears and Woodridge Wild Rookie Leagues (Tier 3 In-House) at Center Ice of DuPage and Seven Bridges Ice Arena, Tier II Travel Hockey "A" and "AA" in the Central States Developmental Hockey League (CDSHL) and Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL), and the Chicago United Hockey League (CUHL) for D1, D2, D3, and Minor Mite divisions.



#### **DuPage Black Bears Rookie League**

The DuPage Black Bear Rookie League is a Tier 3 in-house league for all ages for those who are just learning to play hockey. The prerequisite for the Rookie League is enrollment in a Learn to Play Hockey class or the approval of our Hockey Director. Rookie League players will play cross-ice games as part of three divisions. Weekly skating classes are available for enrolled Skating Academy students, along with team practices based on USA Hockey Player Development principles. Players take part in Cross-Ice games twice a week. Skills and practice sessions run for 30 minutes on two days each week, followed by 20-minute Cross-Ice games on the same days. Division 1 will consist of Little Hockey 1–3 players, Division 2 will include Beginner Hockey 1 & 2 players, and Division 3 will feature Black Bear Prep players. All divisions will be split into equal teams for balanced gameplay.

#### **DuPage Black Bears Travel Teams**

The following travel teamsare for moreadvanced skaters looking to make bigger time commitment and further their skill development. Team travel can range from the local Chicagoland suburbs for basic travel teams, plus Midwest tournaments and showcases for intermediate and top-tier travel teams. Placement on the following teams will be determined by tryouts.

#### 8U, 10U, 12U & 14U Travel Team Fees Include:

Team fees cover league registration, officials, coaching, and ice timefor two practices and one power skate per week. Players will have home game slots, outdoor off-ice position training (weather permitting), and will average 1–2 games per week, totaling around 40 league games for the season. Players **wearing their travel game jersey receive free admission** to Stick n Puck, Public Skate, and Youth Rat Hockey—just sign in at the front desk upon arrival.

#### Mandatory Team Slush Fund (Separate from Registration Fee):

Each team also collects a separate slushfund to covertournament fees(usually2–4 events, both local and out-of-town), hotel and travel expenses for non-parent coaches, playoff play-in games (for 10U, 12U, and 14U), state tournament costs (for 10U, 12U, and 14U), and miscellaneous team events. The slush fund amount varies by team.

#### **Team Selection and Roster Commitment**

**IMPORTANT:** You will receive an email aftertryouts with notification of teamplacement. Team selection notification emails will be sent to the email used for registration within the Players' account. Within the email, there will be a link in which you are required to click and process a "team commitment payment". Once payment is processed and accepted, then and only then, will the player be placed on the roster. If you do not click the link and make a "team commitment payment" within 24 HOURS, the team selection will be reversed and offered to the next player competing for that spot. **No exceptions.** Teams WILL NOT be posted on the website until **after** the roster is finalized with all committed players.

No refunds or credits will be issued. Any player trying out for a travel team is required to pay the full **tryout fee before the first of their tryouts.** 

#### **Goalie Discount**

Mite and above, full-time goalies with theirown gear willreceive a **40% discount** off the published player season fee. Goalies do not receive a discount on the team slush fund amount or on any tournament fees.

#### **Player Suspensions**

If a player's account becomes delinquent, they willbe immediately suspended from all club activities until the balance is paid. Accounts not current by December 20th may result in permanent removal from the team roster. Balances past due after December 20th are still required to be paid in full and will incur a \$50 late fee per month until resolved. Returned checks, declined cards, or other failed payments will result in a \$50 NSF fee per occurrence, in addition to player suspension. Requests to delay payment may also lead to suspension.

### Jersey/Uniform Information

The DuPage Black Bears are proud to wear one of the most unique uniforms in all of youth hockey. Players can wear them from year to year as long as they fit properly and are in good condition (no rips, no severe discoloration). All Black Bears players are required to have a complete uniform set, which includes home and away jerseys, pant shells, and matching home and away socks. Please note that uniforms are not included in the player registration fees and must be ordered and paid for separately through our website. To avoid delays, we encourage all families to place their orders as soon as possible.

Uniform Guidelines & Requirements: Players with even birth years must choose an available

even jersey number. Players with odd birth years must choose an available odd jersey number. **Before** placing your uniform order, email your top three number choices to Scott Maeder. We will try our best to accommodate number requests, but final assignments are based on availability. Jersey numbers will remain with the player for as long as they continue with the program without interruption. If a player leaves the Black Bears for a full year, their number becomes available to others with the same birth year. Number conflicts will be handled directly by the apparel coordinator, who will work with families to resolve any issues. All jersey orders are final and non-refundable. Uniforms are managed and fulfilled by our official partner, Breakaway Sports. All travel team players are required to wear black helmets. Hockey gloves must align with the Black Bears color scheme. Helmet stickers are provided free of charge to any player who needs them.


