

How to Pitch TENx10 to Your Youth Worker

We'd recommend saying/sending them something like:

You got into youth ministry because you love Jesus and you love young people! Your heart is to see young people have a faith that lasts a lifetime. You want to see them have the full and abundant life that Jesus offers, and you watch all the things that get in the way of that.

TENx10 was founded in response to the reality that one million young people are walking away from the Christian faith every year, but to you, we know what really matters is the one. The one student that you journeyed with consistently for months or years, who has walked away from their faith.

We're all asking ourselves, "What could we do differently?" And yet, we've all been taught to do youth ministry, to do church, in a way that doesn't always give us much room for change. What if we told you there's a way to reorient your ministry so that young people have a better shot at having a faith that lasts a lifetime?

That's what we're inviting you to consider, a new way of embodying an ancient call: relational discipleship radically focused on Jesus.
