

Pharmacy Savings Program

The Pharmacy Savings Program (PSP) is Family Health Services' financial assistance program intended to provide financial support when a patient's finances result in a barrier to receiving medically necessary and appropriate care. By way of example, if a certain drug or medicine has been deemed to be medically warranted and your insurance will not cover such drug or medicine or if your out of pocket expense is too high and the price you may have to pay to obtain such drug or medicine would place an undue burden on you or your family, Family Health Services' PSP can provide financial assistance. Simply stated, "but for" receiving financial assistance from Family Health Services you would be unwilling to pay for the drug or medicine due to the undue burden.

Documentation of your need to participate in the PSP may be obtained through the intake process.
