- **Exam training (high school):** For high school students preparing for their final exams. We offer focused training programmes on key exam topics, practising with mock exams.
- **Exam training (MBO, HBO, WO):** For students preparing exams. We help you review the course materials and ensure you're well-prepared for the content of your exams.

Our approach.



Quality education, period.

And that starts with a clear and structured approach, so you know exactly what you can expect. From the initial introduction and intake interview to the final evaluation, we ensure you receive the best support and achieve your goals, with an **approach that works for you.**

Request.

Interested in our support? It all starts with a request. You can easily get in touch via our [website](#), by sending us an [email](#), leaving a message on WhatsApp, or a phone call. Whatever works best for you.

Once we have received your request, one of our team leaders will contact you as soon as possible. Together, we will discuss the possibilities and schedule an intake interview straight away.

Intake interview.

During the intake interview ³ we will get to know you and (for underaged pupils and students) your parent(s) or guardian(s). This interview takes place via Google Meet and includes one of our team leaders and your student-tutor(s).

Why do we have an intake interview? Simple. The intake interview is primarily about discussing your current situation and identifying the challenges you're facing.

We will also explore the kind of support you need to achieve your goals. Based on this, we will collaboratively create an Action Plan.

Action Plan.

During the intake meeting, the team leader, together with you and your student-tutor(s), will create a personalised Action Plan ³. Think of it as the blueprint for your support. It provides a clear overview and outlines the steps we will take to help you achieve your goals and potential.

Agreements.

Your Action Plan forms the basis for the agreements we make together ³. We will decide where to focus our efforts: Which subjects will we cover? How much time will we dedicate to each subject?

Sometimes, we may choose to focus one or two subjects initially, so you don't feel overwhelmed. We continuously evaluate and adjust the agreements as needed.

Trial lessons.

The first lesson is a trial lesson ³. The trial lesson gives your student-tutor a chance to get to know you better. Together, you'll discuss what is needed to provide the best possible support. You'll also briefly review the Action Plan and agreements. This part typically takes no longer than 15 to 30 minutes. The remainder of the lesson is spent working on your subjects, giving you a first-hand experience of how we work.

The trial lesson helps determine whether there's a good match between you and your student-tutor, and whether the support meets your needs. Was the trial lesson a success? Great! The lessons will continue immediately, and the trial lesson will be charged like any regular lesson.

Not satisfied with the trial lesson? No problem, both the first and, if necessary, a second trial lesson are completely free of charge.

Lesson plans.

To ensure structure and consistency, we make use of lessons plans ³. Together with your student-tutor, you'll aim to plan your lessons as far in advance as possible. This schedule will be recorded in our web application ⁴, so you'll always know where, when, and what your lesson will cover.

We understand that life can be hectic and busy for both you and your student-tutor. Planning ahead can be a challenge, which is why we make it easy to adjust the lesson plan if anything changes. While we aim for a schedule that extends to the next evaluation, we also leave room for flexibility.

Start of support.

After a successful trial lesson, your support starts ³ in line with the Action Plan and the agreements made. You'll receive a registration form so that everything can be finalised.

The lessons can be conducted either individually or in small groups (max. 4 people). Do you prefer in-person or online support? It all depends on your preferences, the agreements made, and the type of support you choose (tutoring, homework support, coaching, training programmes, or language lessons/courses).

We listen to your needs and consider your learning style, ensuring you achieve your full potential.

Please note!

Our training programmes, language courses, and single lessons/sessions follow a different process when starting the support.

Single lessons/sessions do not include an intake interview, Action Plan, or trial lesson. For training programmes and language courses that involve a complete programme, these elements are optional.

Please be aware that training programmes, language courses and single lessons/sessions only begin once your registration form has been received.

Progress and evaluations.

We will regularly evaluate your progress ³. After each lesson, a lesson report will be recorded in our web application. This report helps us effectively monitor your progress.

In addition, we schedule evaluation interviews to discuss how things are going. Are there any adjustments needed to the Action Plan or the agreements? Your input is crucial here. Together, we ensure that the support continues to meet your needs.

At the end, there will always be a final evaluation interview. During this interview, we discuss together how to proceed: will your support be extended, adjusted, or concluded?

The evaluation interview always includes you. If parent(s) or guardian(s) do not wish to have an evaluation interview or are unable to attend the planned interview, they will receive a brief summary of the evaluation interview by email.

End of support.

It all ends when your goals are achieved, for example, after passing an exam or when you can continue independently. Your support can also be ended early, depending on what you want and need.

When the support ends, we ensure everything is neatly wrapped up so that you can move forward with confidence.

Let's not forget.

In addition to our personalised education, there are a few practical matters that are useful to know. Below, we have outlined the key points, so you'll know exactly what to expect.

Invoicing.

After a successful trial lesson, you'll receive a registration form. Here, you can specify the account from which the invoice will be debited. The lessons for a given month are billed at the end of that month. We charge based on the actual duration of the lessons, rounded to the nearest quarter-hour (15 minutes). You won't need to manually transfer the payment, as the amount will be automatically debited after 14 days.

We understand that not everyone can use direct debit. For those, we offer the option of making a manual transfer. To arrange this, we ask that you contact one of our team leaders to organise it together.

Subject agreements.

To ensure quality and success, we maintain a minimum hours agreement for our services ³. This means that during the intake interview, we will agree on a minimum number of hours per subject per week. These agreements remain in place until the next evaluation.

If you've chosen a training programme or language course, you simply follow the hours set for each lesson or programme.

Please note!

During the evaluation interview, we will check whether the agreed hours have been completed. **If you have taken fewer lessons than the minimum hours agreed, we will charge the difference.** This is done by multiplying the missing hours (rounded to the nearest quarter-hour) by the hourly rate. This amount will appear on the invoice for the month in which the evaluation interview takes place.

Single lessons and sessions.

Do you want to quickly refresh or brush up on certain knowledge? Or would you like to get acquainted with our services? Our single lessons and sessions offer the flexibility you need, but it's your responsibility to direct the focus based on your goals.

- **Who is it for:** For pupils and students who require one-off or short-term help, for example, when preparing for tests or exams.
- **Features:** Easy and flexible to schedule, providing quick help with specific questions or topics where you need that extra boost.

Since single lessons and sessions are designed for short, practical help, they **do NOT include an intake interview, Action Plan, agreements, or trial lesson.**

Ongoing support and complete programmes.

Our ongoing support provides tailored assistance. We listen to your needs and adapt the lessons and the materials to what works for you.

- **Who is it for:** For pupils and students who want to work systematically towards long-term goals, such as improving grades or developing study skills.
- **Features:** Regular lessons designed to help you achieve goals that require more time, so you can finally get a handle on subjects or topics you've been struggling with.

Cancelled lessons.

Sometimes, unexpected events like illness or other unforeseen circumstances arise. No worries! If you cancel the lesson **before 08:30** (CET/CEST) on the day of the lesson, **no charges will apply**. Just let us know as soon as possible, and we will work together to find a suitable solution for you.

Neglected lessons.

If you cancel **later than 08:30** (CET/CEST) on the day of the lesson, or if a lesson cannot proceed because you unexpectedly fail to attend, this will be considered a neglected lesson. Neglected lessons **will be charged in full**.

If there are exceptional circumstances or a case of force majeure, please let us know, and we will work with you to explore the possibilities.

Lesson materials.

You're responsible for bringing your own lesson materials, such as school and study books, as well as any assignments. If needed, we will provide additional materials, such as practice exercises for your exams. Together, we work towards thorough preparation.

If certain materials are difficult to obtain, or if you are missing answer keys, we will see if we can arrange these for you.
