

Ring Sizing Chart

Instructions

Step 1
Print this page on standard A4. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to “None” or “100%” in the print dialogue box.

Step 2
Once printed, measure the scale bar (right) to ensure it is exactly 50mm long.

Match your ring size

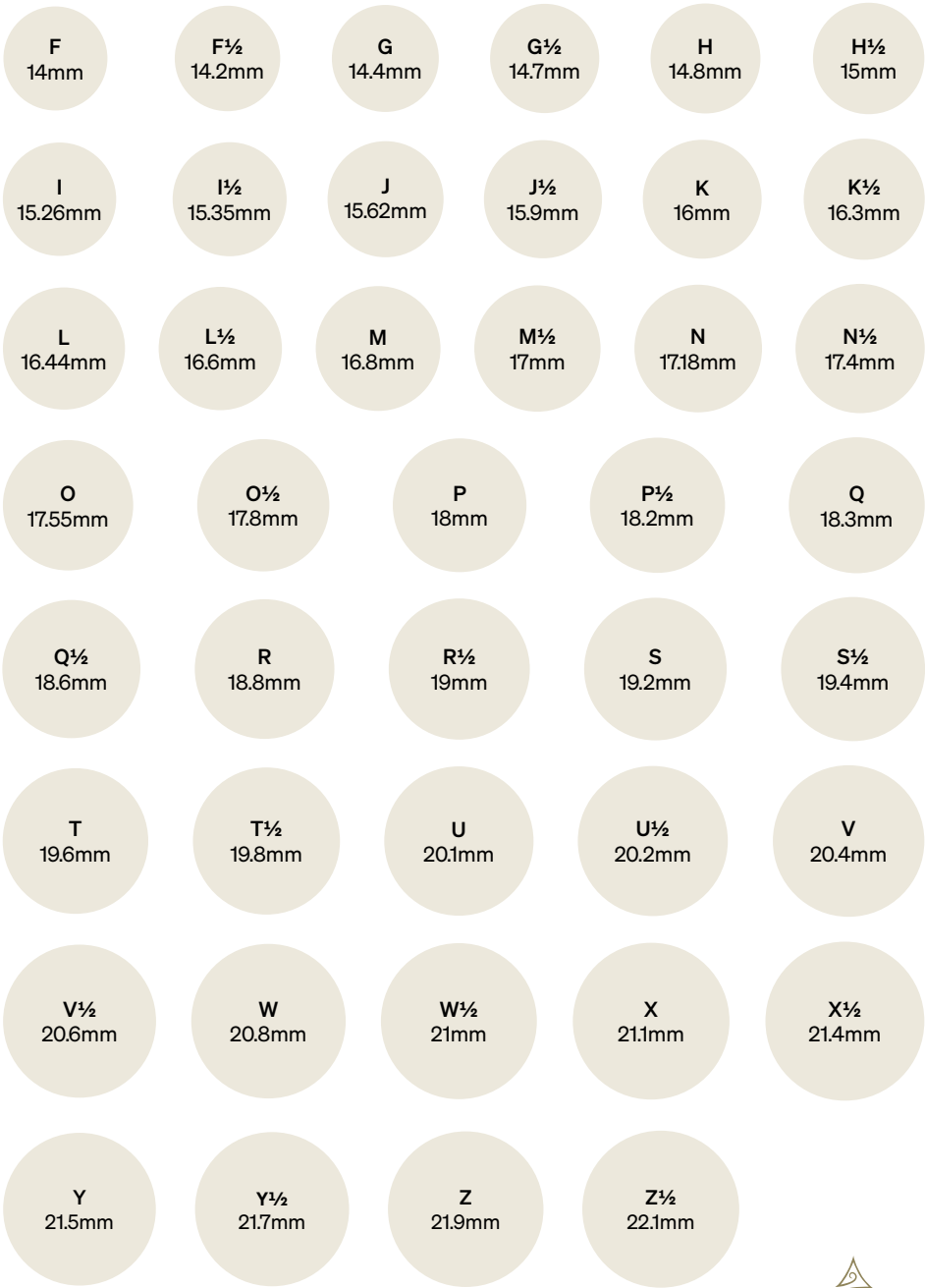
Step 1
Select a ring you own which fits the finger you intend to wear your new ring on.

Step 2
Place the ring over the nearest matching circles on the right. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.

Step 3
If you fall between two sizes, or between a full and half size, it's recommended to select the larger size to ensure a comfortable fit.

Step 4
You can double-check your size by measuring the inside diameter of your ring with a ruler, and ensuring it matches the measurements shown in the circles.
