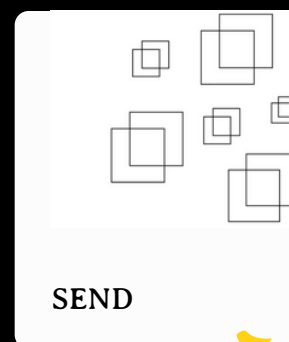
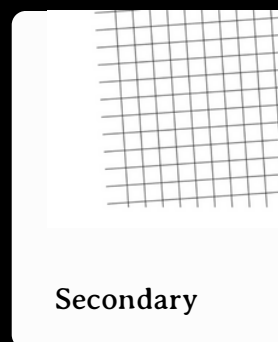
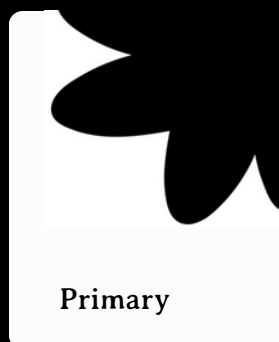
Fun Fact!

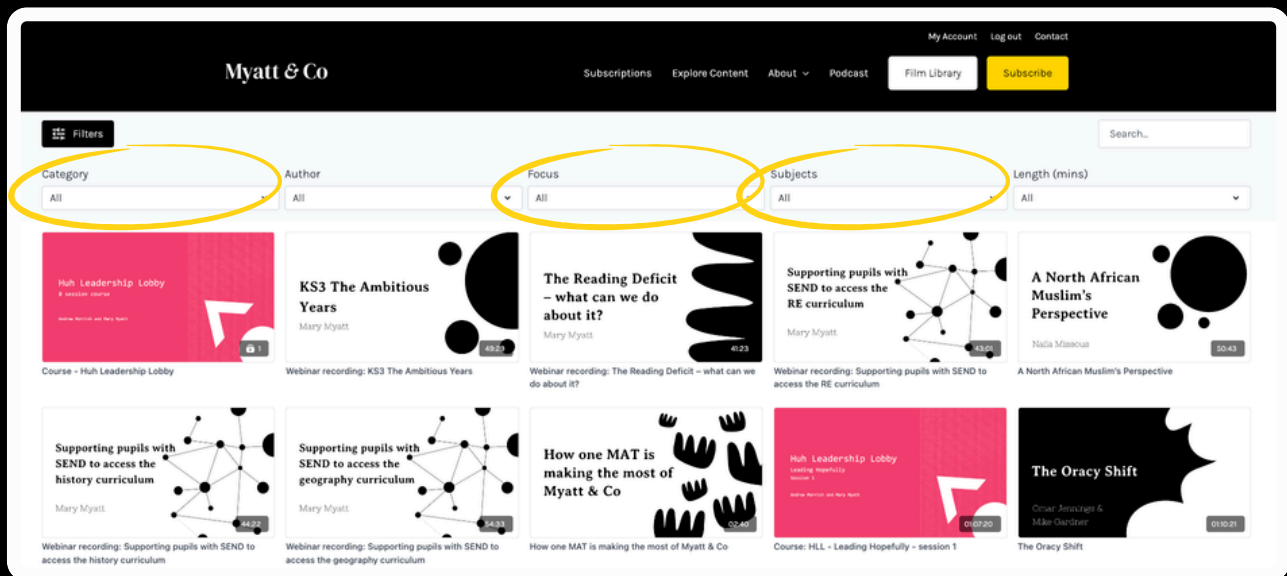

Omar and Mike reflect on the fascinating evolution from their school's focus on reading resulting in an intentional and powerful oracy approach. They explain the concept of 'Number Talks' and the use of Kagan structures to promote equity and support cognitive development. These pedagogical tools, structuring conversations in the classroom they found not only enhanced learning but also engagement.

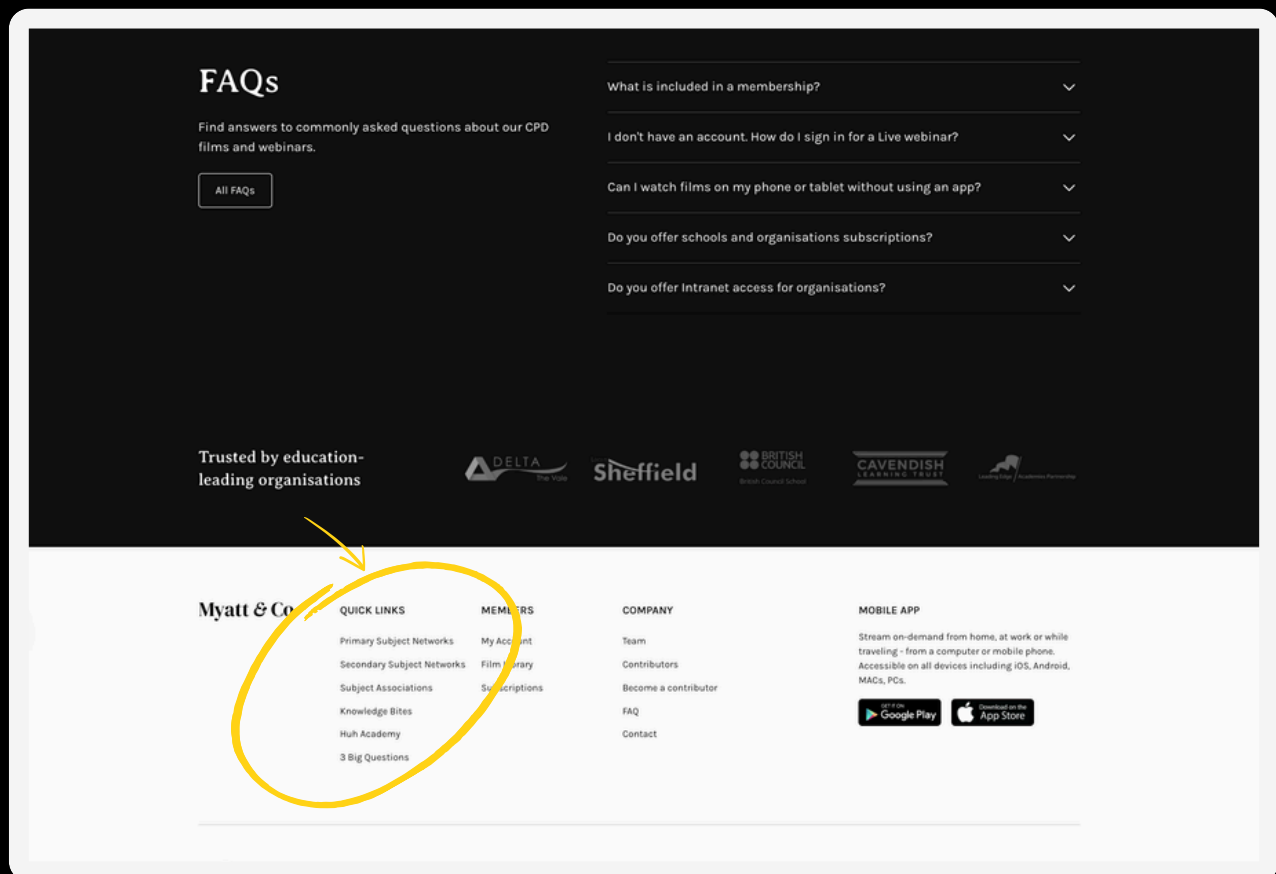
What we love is that you can listen to a recording as an audio, you can also come out of the app and the audio still plays.
