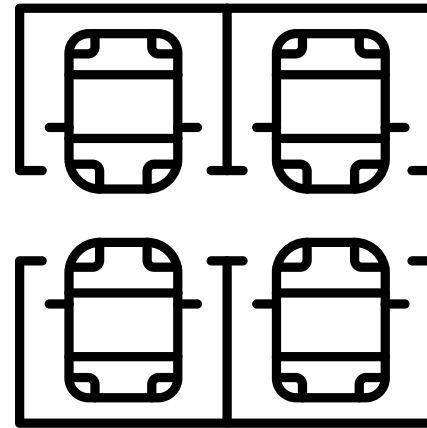

The AsIAm Same Chance Walk will begin at 11am. You can arrive from 10am to enjoy the space, activities, or to register on the day.



AsIAm Staff will be on site to advise you on where to park. There may be a wait for parking as stewards navigate people into their parking spaces

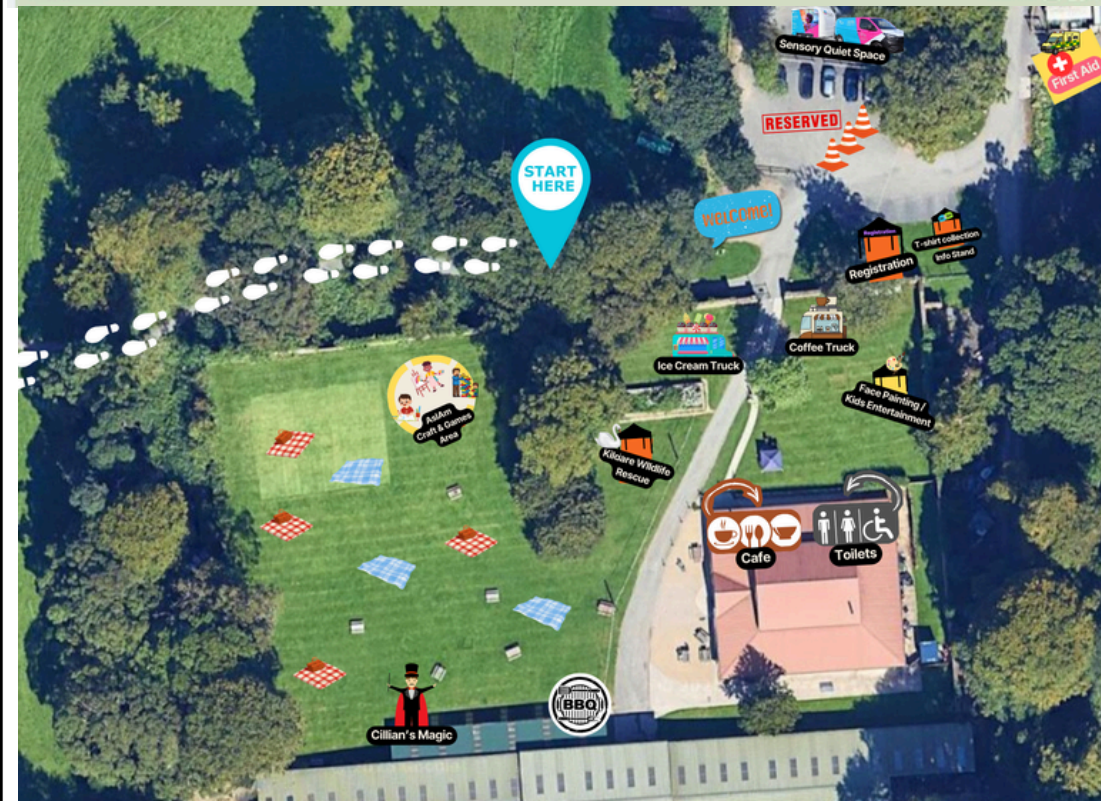


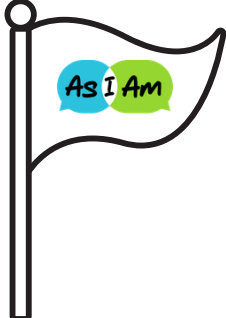


If you are registering on the day, you can go to the AsIAM Registration tent.



You can take your ticket for t-shirts over to the T-shirt collection tent.





After the Welcome and Safety messages, the Same Chance Walk will begin. We will be following the green route. If you would like to do a shorter route, AsI Am staff will be positioned along the route to advise on directions. There will also be signs to indicate where you are.

Note: Some areas have more uneven ground, and may be more difficult to push a buggy around.



If you would prefer not to do the walk, that is ok. You are welcome to relax and enjoy the activities, entertainment and arts and crafts that are in the walled garden.

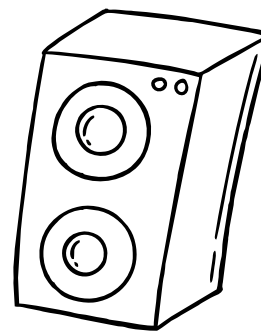
There will also be a sensory area and you are welcome to bring any fidgets or aids that you need for the day.



There will be an AsIAm Autism Information Stand where you can approach AsIAm staff and ask for autism-specific advice or guidance.

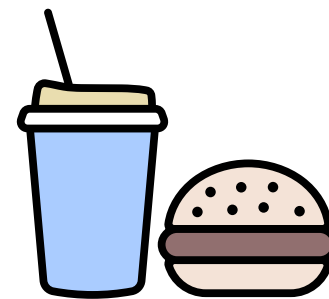


There will be donation buckets and QR codes to donate on your phone at the location on the day.



We will be playing music at a low volume through the day and there will be microphones used for the welcome address and safety announcements.

Children should be supervised by parents or guardians at all times.

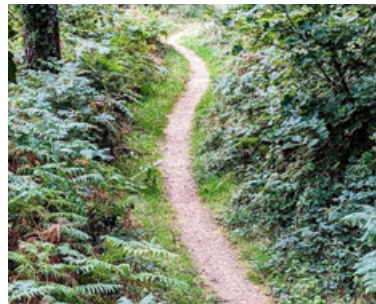


There will be stalls and trucks to buy food from on the day, but you are welcome to bring your own drinks and snacks if you prefer.

Dogs are most welcome, but they must be kept on a lead for their safety, and the safety of other dogs, fellow Walk participants, members of the public and on-site farm animals. Please ensure to bring adequate water, food and poop bags.

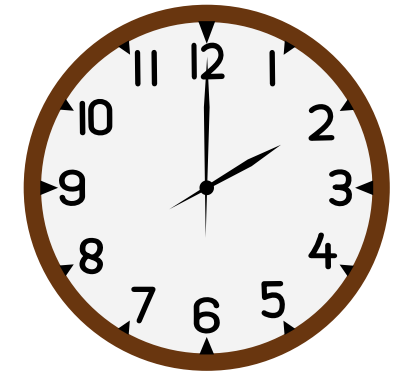
