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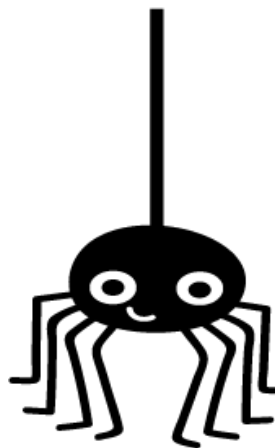
**At home on Halloween I will have a party with my family.
We may watch movies and eat Halloween treats .**



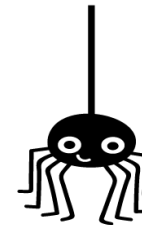
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
