## Overview

Jayelen House is certainly entertaining. When watching his tape, it's hard to miss how confident of a player he is on the field. As a signal caller, House displays dominance in commanding the offense and catering to the strengths of his receivers. His escape ability in the pocket is elite and is on a Division 1 level. He has great length to complement his speed which allows him to extend plays. Instead of having to take a sack or run, he can buy himself several seconds to look for a play downfield. House is an underrecruited player who needs to be on a collegiate roster. He passes the eye test on every evaluation level and is entertaining to watch. His ability to make plays while not committing many turnovers is also a huge asset. I would like to see him display more passing attempts for a larger sample size and feel he would be garnering significantly more attention if that were the case. That being said, what we are seeing stands off the page and should put him in more conversations.

## Strengths

- Excellent running abilities.
- Great decision maker when looking downfield.
- Elite athleticism and length that grants him an advantage against defensive lineman.
- Confident signal caller when running a play.
- You can tell he feeds into the strengths of his playmaker's, setting them up to allow them to make a play themselves.
- Stays in the pocket with a great upright stance.

## Weaknesses

- Relies more heavily on his running abilities and would like to see him throw the ball more in order to see a larger sample size of his decision making.
- Does not often run out of bounds quickly to reduce risk of injury.
- Has not always faced the toughest opponent week-to-week, but has dominated when facing inferior competition.
