WSSU really got a steal with this guy. He has good ball hawk instincts, holds a bigger offensive player down until help comes, scans the field consistently and well and can lay the shoulder onto a player. I truly see a player that is impacted by older players in programs who are utilizing years on years of eligibility and taking up a roster spot that otherwise could have gone to a more raw, developmental type of player like Derrick. His height is suitable for almost any program but he'd need to increase his weight to compete at D1 level. His tape is great and the amount of highlights he produced from each game is not normal, it suggests a great player that with the right program or coach can really produce value. He has great balance shown in his incredible hurdle times and with a good strength program is ready to make a real impact. I wouldn't be surprised to see him pursued in the portal after some time at WSSU

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
