

Important Notes:

Air Travel – Is not included in our guides. For an estimate of flight prices, we recommend using [Google Flights](#). Keep in mind that flights around holidays are often more expensive. Insurance – Is not included in our guides. Travel insurance is not included, as standard policies typically cost between \$100 - \$250 for tropical vacations.

Transfers – Most of the time, transfers are included. Per person transfers can range between \$50 - \$350 depending on distance, shared vs private, and the quantity of passengers.
