Time of Year - If your schedule is flexible, consider booking your trip outside of major holidays. Christmas, New Years, and the month of July will always be more expensive. Another option would be traveling during "shoulder seasons" (March - May and September - October) popular destinations are less crowded, have lower rates, and the weather is usually good!

Length of Trip - Consider shortening up your trip and saving some items on your itinerary for the next vacation! 4-5 nights is often perfect amount of time for a tropical getaway!

Airport - Often flying out of larger airports can provide better rates. When looking at air travel, be sure to check out other nearby options! However, be sure to factor in gas, parking, or if a hotel stay would be needed as those can add up quickly. Don't forget to check your credit card points, those can be used if you book your own air!

Hurricane Season - June–November is considered "hurricane season" in tropical destinations, with the highest activity typically from August to October. During this time, you'll often find lower rates and occasional rain, but storms usually pass quickly. The weather is often better than the forecast suggests, so don't let predictions discourage you unless a named storm is actually expected.
