Program Outline

Ground School

Cadets will prepare for written DGCA and WPC examinations.

Ground training will cover:

- · Air Navigation
- Aviation Meteorology
- · Air Regulations
- · Technical General
- · Technical specific (SE)
- · Technical Specific (ME)
- · Radio Telephony
- · Aviation English Language Proficiency (ELP)

The Ground School will be conducted at CAA's on-campus facility with experienced instructors and exposure to the airport operations.

Flying Training (CPL - IR/ME)

Cadets will be trained on a fleet of modern Cessna 172/Piper Archer DX/ Technam P2010 TDi aircraft, equipped with the latest generation Garmin G1000 NXi glass cockpit and safety equipment.

Simulator training will be done on DGCA-approved aircraft simulators.

Flying training will include:

- 185 hours on Single Engine Aircraft
- · 15 hours on Multi-Engine Aircraft
- · 30 Hours Simulator Flying

Type Rating

After obtaining their Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL), the cadet will proceed to advanced training of Airbus A320 with MCC/JOT, UPRT at an IndiGo-approved TRTO partner in India or overseas.

Program Duration

This is a full-time 20-month Program.



Eligibility Criteria

Age Candidates should be between 18 and 35 years of age at the time of application

Academic Qualification 10+2 with minimum score of 51% / Grade Point 6 / Grade C1 (CBSE) – Individually in each subject i.e. Physics / Mathematics / English

A Higher Degree that includes these subjects with a minimum passing score of 51%.

Candidates must be fluent in English- written and verbal.

Medical Qualification & Candidates should be able to obtain and maintain DGCA Class 1 Medical Fitness

BMI certificate Certificate with no limitations.

Cadets must submit a BMI certificate (18–25 range) from a NABL-accredited hospital or lab.

Passport & Background Check

Must have a valid Indian passport with the ability to travel unrestricted worldwide.

The candidates must also be able to produce a Criminal Record Check (CRC) Basic

Disclosure Certificate, and pass all IndiGo and CAA reference checks.

Tattoos Candidates with visible tattoos will not be considered


