


Levante Unión Deportiva is the oldest club in Valencia and carries a unique "neighborhood" identity. Known as the *Granotas* (The Frogs), the name stems from their original ground near the old Turia riverbed, which was home to a loud population of frogs. This humble, resilient beginning has defined their culture as a "giant-killer" club that prides itself on being the authentic voice of its community.

Social Inclusion Leader: Through its "Cent Any" Foundation, Levante is a global benchmark for adapted sports. They manage over 100 players with intellectual disabilities (Levante UD EDI) and support elite paralympic athletes, integrating them fully into the club's professional structure.

Sustainable Infrastructure: Rather than building a new stadium, the club modernized the Estadio Ciutat de València. This included an ultra-lightweight tensile roof to minimize carbon-heavy materials and a full transition to high-efficiency LED lighting.

Pioneers in Women's Football: They were one of the first Spanish clubs to professionalize their women's section, becoming a historic powerhouse and a platform for gender equality in the sport.


Structured Approach to Post-Match Waste Management

The partnership between Leonardo GR and Levante UD establishes a structured and measurable approach to post-match waste management at the Ciutat de València stadium. Leonardo GR's operational responsibility begins immediately after each home match, once the event concludes and stadium cleaning activities are activated. At that point, the company assumes control of the waste management process across all designated stadium sectors.

Leonardo GR coordinates the systematic collection of waste generated during the event, ensuring materials are gathered efficiently and handled according to established environmental procedures. The collected waste is then transported to authorised sorting facilities, where it is classified by material type and accurately weighed to ensure full traceability and quantitative control. Recyclable fractions are processed through certified recovery channels, enabling their reintegration into the circular economy.

This structured workflow ensures regulatory compliance, operational efficiency, and environmental accountability. In addition, the generation of verified recovery data allows Levante UD to monitor recycling rates, measure landfill diversion, and evaluate the environmental performance of stadium operations in a transparent and consistent manner.






Operational & Governance Impact



Levante UD integrates blockchain-based traceability into its environmental strategy through the use of a Cardano wallet, enabling transparent management of its plastic credits. Notably, the credits associated with this initiative were among the first to be minted on the Cardano mainnet, reinforcing the club's early commitment to secure, verifiable, and tamper-resistant environmental action. This approach ensures full traceability from recovery to credit issuance, positioning Levante UD at the forefront of digital innovation in sustainable sports management.
