Spotlight on Community Benefits Moreland-Hughes Rehabilitation Center.

Occupational therapy (OT), Physical therapy (PT), and Speech Therapy (ST) are all crucial rehabilitative services aimed at improving a patient's quality of life and function, but they focus on different aspects: Physical therapy targets restoring and enhancing physical mobility, strength, and balance, while occupational therapy focuses on helping individuals engage in daily activities and "occupations" that are meaningful to their lives. Speech therapy is an integral part of the rehabilitation process, particularly for seniors recovering from neurological conditions. The effectiveness of speech therapy significantly increases when it is integrated with PT and OT. Speech therapy can target issues with both speech and hearing, as well as swallowing in patients recovering from a stroke or injury.



At Moreland-Hughes Rehabilitation Services on the Campus of The Ohio Eastern Star Home, PT, OT and ST often work in conjunction, collaborating to provide a holistic approach to patient recovery. For instance, a physical therapist might improve a patient's ability to stand, while an occupational therapist then helps that patient use assistive devices for tasks like getting dressed or navigating their home. These professions require advanced degrees, are board-certified, and aim to empower individuals to achieve their goals and improve their overall well-being.

Rehabilitation at The Ohio Eastern Star Home can provide both in-patient or out-patient therapy, making it easily available to our guests and residents, as well as offering a great resource to the greater Knox County community. At the OES Home, we partner with Functional Pathways OT, PT and ST therapists, who work in tandem with our nurses and caregivers to assure a successful team approach with positive outcomes, allowing our quests to return home to their daily lives.
