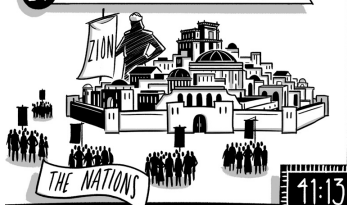

Psalm 3
