


Psalm 27

 Cast me not off; forsake me not, O God of my salvation! For my
 father and my mother have forsaken me, but the Lord will take
 me in. Teach me your way, O Lord, and lead me on a level path
 because of my enemies. Give me not up to the will of my
 adversaries; for false witnesses have risen against me,
 and they breathe out violence. I believe that I shall look upon
 the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living! Wait for the
 Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage;
 wait for the Lord!


