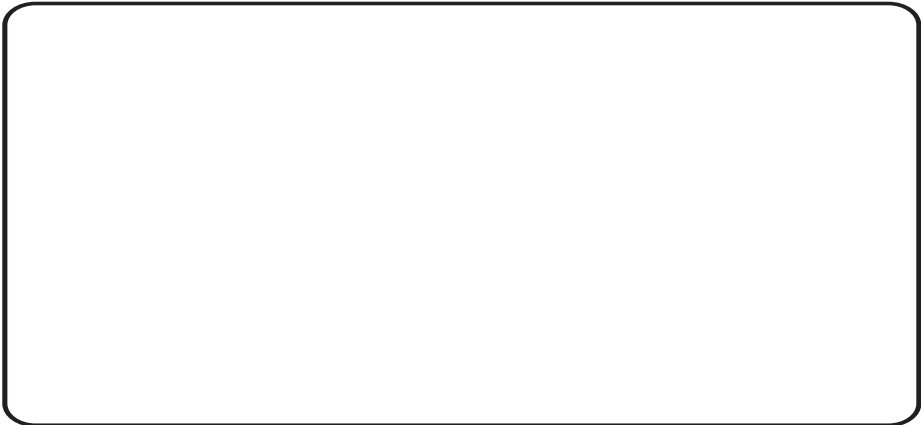


Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven,
