Policy Commitments:

- Legal Compliance:
 - Maintain a Legal Compliance Register and uphold our membership with Barbour EHS to ensure access to the latest legislation.
- Sustainability Management:
 - Conduct regular inspections and address corrective actions promptly.
 - Follow the LMB Office (Health, Safety, and Sustainability) Plan and Risk Assessments to manage sustainability at our head office and yard.
- Site Sustainability:
 - Conform to the sustainability requirements of Principle Contractors (PC) on client sites.
 - Engage in minimal influence sustainability practices as applicable.
- Training and Awareness:
 - Cover sustainability and environmental risks in site-specific Risk Assessments and Method Statements (RAMS).
 - Conduct sustainability-focused toolbox talks and ensure all operatives attend RAMS inductions and understand their contents.
 - Train Site Managers through the Site Managers Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS), focusing on environmental management and waste management.
- Energy and Water Usage:
 - Promote energy efficiency through toolbox talks or company Campinas.
 - Manage mortar silos efficiently, maintaining them in designated areas to reduce water usage and prevent spills.
- Waste Management:
 - Comply with PC Site Waste Management Plans (SWMPs), aiming for reuse and recycling of materials such as scaffold boards.
 - Implement good housekeeping practices to minimize waste and damage.
- Material Sourcing:
 - Opt for materials with recycled content and sustainable alternatives where possible.
 - Use suppliers accredited to ISO 14001 and consider local suppliers to reduce environmental impact.
- Pollution Control:
 - Adhere to Environment Agency Pollution Prevention Guidelines (PPGs).
 - Store fuels and chemicals safely and conduct regular toolbox talks on proper handling.
