

Class of 2030 Dominican Scholar Award

For the class of **2030**, Catholic Central is pleased to offer the Dominican Scholar Award. These scholarships will be awarded to incoming freshmen who exemplify at least one of the Dominican Pillars: *Study, Prayer, Service, and Community.*

Dominican Scholar Award recipients will be awarded \$500-\$1,500 toward their 2026-27 tuition.

How to apply: In order to be considered for an award, prospective students <u>must do all</u> of the following:

- Complete Catholic Central's online Freshman Admission Application <u>no later than</u> <u>December 1, 2025.</u>
- Respond, through either a thought-provoking essay or video, to the following three questions, no later than December 1, 2025:
 - 1. Short response (50-100 written words) What do the four Dominican Pillars, listed above, mean to you and which one(s) do you exemplify in your life?
 - 2. Short response (50-100 written words) Please explain, in detail, what you have accomplished or how you have excelled based on the Pillar(s) you exemplify.
 - 3. Long response (100-200 written words): The true cost of a 4-year Catholic Central education for each student in the Class of 2030 is close to \$60,000. If you were given \$60,000, how would you use that money to make a positive difference?
- Provide the following information, on a separate document page, along with the essay or video, no later than December 1, 2025:

Perform well in a personal interview. Interviews with Applicant and Parent(s) will be scheduled in December/January.

How to Submit the Application: All essays and/or videos should be submitted to the Admissions Department at Catholic Central High School **no later than December 1, 2025**. Submissions should be emailed to: <u>admissions@grcatholiccentral.org</u>.

A parent will receive a confirmation email when the submission has been received.

The Dominican Scholar Awards are <u>not</u> athletic scholarships and do <u>not</u> require a Tuition Assistance Application to be considered for the award.
