

ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

In the spirit of our Catholic mission, the majority of Catholic Central's scholarships are intended for families with the greatest need. Typically, recipients are in the top quartile of financial need. Applicants are not guaranteed a scholarship. The total number of scholarships and amounts awarded are based upon the funds available.

Scholarship Guidelines:

- One (1) student per scholarship application; applications with multiple student names will be ineligible.
- Each scholarship requires its own SEPARATE and COMPLETE application.
- Need-based scholarship applications require completed Blackbaud Financial Aid applications
 (greatholiccentral.org/admissions/tuition-assistance) due December 1, 2025 for priority consideration.
 Non-need-based scholarships do not require Blackbaud Financial Aid applications.
- Incomplete or late applications will not be eligible for consideration.
- Scholarships are awarded directly to the recipient's tuition account. No money will be given to students or their families.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified when tuition statements are mailed.

Submitting your scholarship application:

- Fill out the Endowed Scholarship Application form completely.
- Include ALL required supporting documentation, including any essay(s), letter(s) of recommendation, verification of community service, or any other documentation required for each specific scholarship.
 Please review each scholarship's requirements on the Catholic Central school website (greatholiccentral.org/scholarships).
- If you are a current CC student or have submitted a report card to Catholic Central Admissions with your new student application, you do not need to submit a copy of your report card with your scholarship application(s).
- Hard copies of letters of recommendation may be submitted with your application. As an alternative, the person writing on your behalf may submit their recommendation online (greatholiccentral.org/scholarships). All letters of recommendation must be submitted by December 1, 2025. A letter of recommendation can be used across multiple scholarship applications. If a scholarship requires more than one letter of recommendation, the additional letter(s) must be from a different person.
- All completed scholarship applications are due December 1, 2025; no exceptions will be made.
 Applications may be turned in to the school office by 3:00 p.m., or may be sent by mail (postmarked December 1, 2025), or may be emailed to scholarships@grcatholiccentral.org by 11:59 p.m. on December 1, 2025.
