

Head-to-head: LiftComm vs. the field.

Every product here meets the elevator code, and several now ship an off-cloud variant. LiftComm goes further. It is not a compliant call box with a screen bolted on: it is a **full communications endpoint inside your network**, running your PBX, your SIP lines, your cameras and your SOC workflows, with no LiftComm cloud in the path.

All products reviewed are ASME A17.1 (2019 / 2022) and IBC 2021 compliant. This sheet compares architecture and integration depth, not code compliance. **RATH SmartView Offline** and **Wurtec WUR-COM On-Prem** are separate on-premises variants of those lines: the standard SmartView 2 configuration uses the SmartView Hub and requires unrestricted internet access, and the standard WUR-COM conveys communications to designated stations over internet or LAN. **MosaicONE** offers an onsite-only mode with no subscription for single buildings with 24/7 onsite staff, and the platform is otherwise cloud native. **VidaTech Thunder** runs on an isolated LAN but relies on VidaTech monitoring, VoIP and cloud data provisioning, with an internet-linked responder platform. Backup power: LiftComm devices draw PoE, so standby power lives in the UPS backed switch plant your IT team already maintains rather than in per-car battery packs. THE BOTTOM LINE

LiftComm wins on depth of customer-controlled integration: an **on-premises PBX with four SIP accounts, programmable and scheduled 911 / PSAP routing, your existing IP cameras and CCTV, native access control and SOC workflows, and no required LiftComm cloud platform.** Everyone else sells the box.
