In 2020, Saburomaru Distillery brewed two types of peat: the traditional inland peat from the Highlands and the sea pear from Islay. The inland peat is different from the Islay Peat. The smokiness is straight and powerful. It also has a dry nuance like burning dry wood. The wooden barrels introduced in the same year allowed for a diverse range of fermentation processes using unique lactic acid bacteria, resulting in a wort that is both fruity and malty. In 2020, Saburomaru Distillery prepared two types of peat: traditional Highland inland peat and Islay sea peat. The inland peat has a more straightforward and powerful smokiness than the Islay peat, with dry, wood-burned dry nuances. The introduction of wooden vats in the same year allowed for a diverse fermentation process with its own lactic acid bacteria, resulting in a wine that is both fruity and malty.
