Explosive

Explosives (divisions 1.1 - 1.4); Unstable explosives; Self-reactive substances and mixtures; Organic peroxides.



Oxidising

Oxidising gases (category 1); Oxidising liquids (categories 1, 2, 3); Oxidising solids, (categories 1, 2, 3).



Flammable

Flammable substances; Pyrophoric substances; Self-heating substances; Substances that emit flammable gases in contact with water.



Corrosive

Skin Corrosion/Burns; Eye Damage; Corrosive to metals.



Toxic

Acute Toxicity (Fatal or Toxic) oral, dermal, inhalation (categories 1, 2, 3).



Compressed Gas

Compressed gases; Liquefied gases; Refrigerated liquefied gases; Dissolved gases.



Irritant

Skin & eye Irritation; Skin sensitisation; Acute Toxicity; Specific target organ toxicity; Narcotic effects; Respiratory irritation; hazardous to the ozone layer.



Health Hazard

Aspiration hazard; Respiratory sensitization; Carcinogenicity; Germ cell mutagenicity; Reproductive toxicity; Specific target organ toxicity.



Environmental Hazard

Acute or chronic hazards to the aquatic environment.
