During Week 6 while everyone is dressing up for Book Week, we will also have lots of books available to purchase in the foyer.

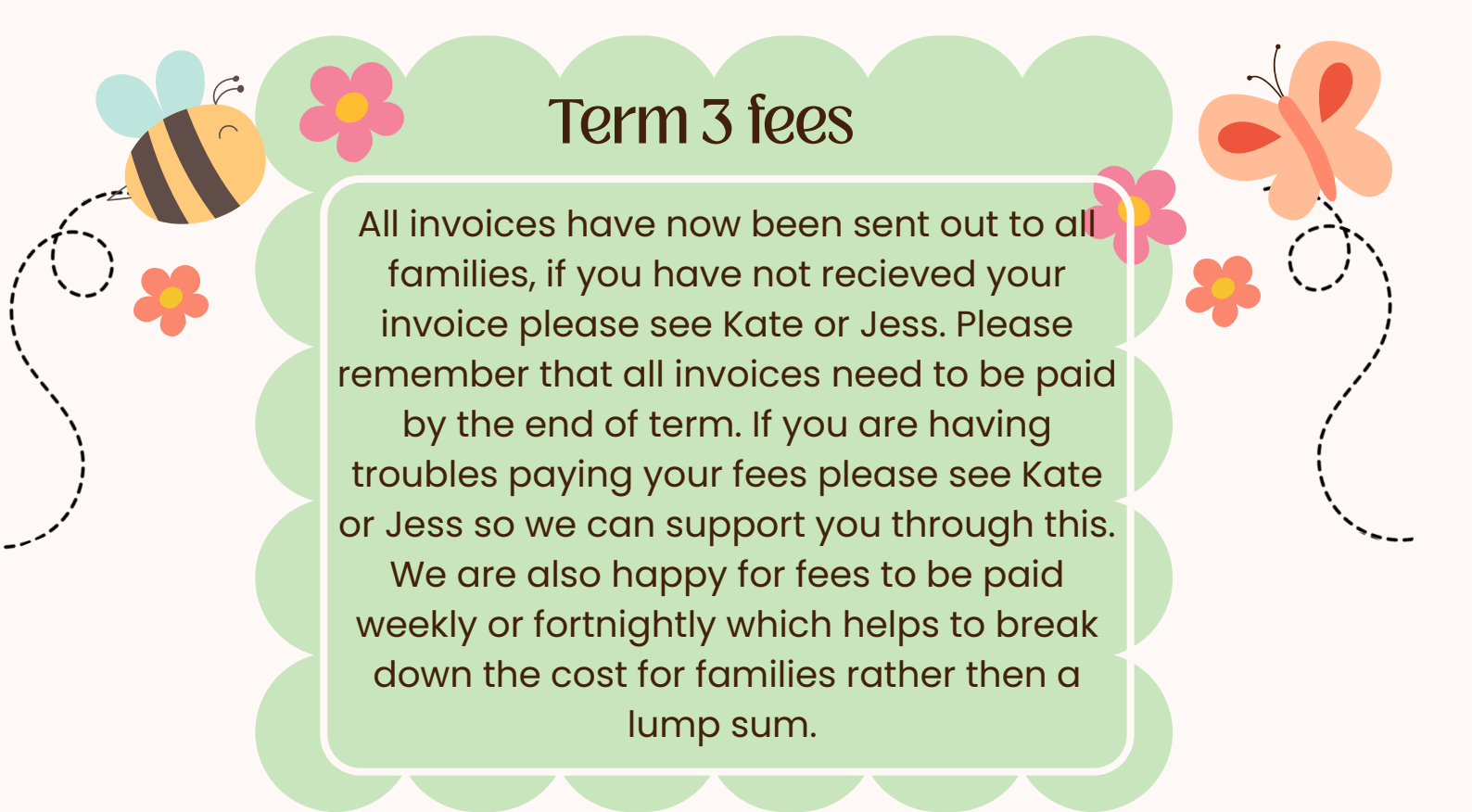
Book Week and the Book Fair will be 24th– 28th August, the theme is a Symphony of Stories
