

# ICCLA Net Zero Achievement Award



This award recognises organisations that have made credible, measurable progress towards achieving net zero emissions through reduction, operational change and clear accountability.

**Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.**

Summary (250 words max)	<b>In no more than 250 words, explain why your organisation deserves to win this award.</b>
Net Zero Strategy and Targets	<b>Describe your organisation's net zero commitment, including targets, timelines and how they align with recognised standards or frameworks.</b>
Emissions Reduction Actions	<b>Provide evidence of actions taken to reduce emissions across operations. This should focus on real reductions rather than planned initiatives.</b>
Measurement and Reporting	<b>Explain how emissions are measured, tracked and reported. This should include scope coverage and data quality.</b>
Emissions Scope and Coverage	<b>Explain which parts of your organisation's emissions are included in your net zero approach. This should clearly show what is being measured and addressed, and whether all relevant activities are covered.</b>
Measurable Progress and Outcomes	<b>Demonstrate progress towards net zero. This should include verified reductions, improvements over time and clear evidence of impact.</b>

## Scoring (100 Points Total)

- Net Zero Strategy and Targets: 20
- Emissions Reduction Actions: 25
- Measurement and Reporting: 15
- Emissions Scope and Coverage: 10
- Measurable Progress and Outcomes: 30

## Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
