

ICCLA Supply Chain Sustainability Award



This award recognises organisations demonstrating strong sustainability performance across their supply chain, including sourcing, supplier management and measurable environmental and social impact.

Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.

Summary (250 words max)	In no more than 250 words, explain why your organisation deserves to win this award.
Sustainable Sourcing	Describe how your organisation selects and works with suppliers. This should include standards, requirements and efforts to ensure responsible sourcing practices.
Supplier Engagement and Oversight	Show how your organisation monitors and supports suppliers in improving sustainability performance. This may include audits, collaboration or performance tracking.
Transparency & Traceability	Demonstrate how your organisation tracks and understands its supply chain. This should include visibility of materials, suppliers and associated risks.
Innovation in the Supply Chain	Provide evidence of new approaches, technologies or processes that improve sustainability across the supply chain.
Measurable Impact and Outcomes	Show the results achieved across your supply chain. This should include reductions in emissions, improved sourcing practices or other measurable improvements.

Scoring (100 Points Total)

- Sustainable Sourcing: 20
- Supplier Engagement and Oversight: 20
- Transparency and Traceability: 15
- Innovation in the Supply Chain: 15
- Measurable Impact and Outcomes: 30

Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
