This award recognises technologies that deliver measurable environmental or climate benefits through practical application and innovation.

Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.

Summary (250 words max)	In no more than 250 words, explain why this innovation deserves to win this award.
Technology Overview	Describe the technology, including what it does, the problem it addresses and how it works in practice
Innovation and Differentiation	Show how the technology is new or improved compared to existing solutions and why it represents a meaningful advancement.
Implementation and Use	Provide evidence of how the technology has been applied in real-world settings. This should include deployment, users and practical use cases.
Scalability and Commercial Viability	Demonstrate the potential for the technology to be adopted more widely, including its ability to scale or be applied in different contexts.
Measurable Impact and Outcomes	Provide clear evidence of results, including environmental benefits, efficiency gains or other measurable improvements.

Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
