

ICCLA Sustainability Team of the Year



This award recognises teams delivering meaningful sustainability outcomes through leadership, collaboration and practical action within their organisation.

Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.

Summary (250 words max)	In no more than 250 words, explain why your team deserves to win this award.
Team Contribution and Leadership	Describe the role of the team in driving sustainability initiatives. This should focus on what the team has led, influenced or delivered within the organisation.
Collaboration and Engagement	Show how the team works with internal stakeholders and external partners to deliver sustainability outcomes.
Innovation and Problem Solving	Provide evidence of new approaches, ideas or solutions developed by the team to address sustainability challenges.
Implementation and Delivery	Demonstrate how the team delivered initiatives in practice, including coordination, execution and adoption across the organisation.
Measurable Results and Impact	Provide clear evidence of results achieved through the team's work, including measurable environmental or organisational improvements.

Scoring (100 Points Total)

- Team Contribution and Leadership: 25
- Collaboration and Engagement: 20
- Innovation and Problem Solving: 15
- Implementation and Delivery: 15
- Measurable Results and Impact: 25

Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
