This award recognises organisations in the built environment delivering meaningful improvements in sustainability and climate resilience through strategy, implementation and measurable results.

Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.

Summary (250 words max)	In no more than 250 words, explain why your organisation deserves to win this award.
Sustainability Strategy	Describe your organisation's approach to sustainability. This should include key initiatives such as energy efficiency, waste reduction, transport improvements or other environmental actions.
Implementation and Delivery	Provide an overview of how your strategy has been implemented across the organisation. This should include communication, leadership involvement and how initiatives were delivered in practice.
Challenges and Problem Solving	Describe the challenges faced in implementing your sustainability initiatives and how they were overcome.
Measurable Outcomes and Results	Demonstrate the results achieved. This should include measurable improvements such as emissions reduction, cost savings, waste reduction or other tangible benefits.
Long-Term Sustainability & Improvement	Show how sustainability is embedded within your organisation and how initiatives are monitored, maintained and improved over time.

- Implementation and Delivery: 20
- Challenges and Problem Solving: 10
- Measurable Outcomes and Results: 30
- Long-Term Sustainability and Improvement: 20

Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
