This award recognises leadership by government agencies, public institutions and civil servants in advancing climate action, resilience and sustainability.

**Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.**

Summary (250 words max)	<b>In no more than 250 words, explain why your organisation deserves to win this award.</b>
Implementation	<b>Describe how climate and sustainability goals are embedded into planning, budgeting and organisational strategy.</b>
Adaptation and Resilience	<b>Outline initiatives that strengthen resilience to climate risks, including protection of communities and infrastructure.</b>
Policy Leadership and Innovation	<b>Demonstrate leadership in developing or implementing climate and sustainability policies, including the use of data, tools or new approaches to guide decision-making.</b>
Community Engagement & Collaboration	<b>Show how your organisation works with communities, partners or stakeholders to support climate action and behavioural change.</b>
Measurable Impact and Outcomes	<b>Provide clear evidence of results, including measurable progress over time supported by data, case studies or evaluations.</b>

## Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
