Organisation of the Year



This award recognises healthcare providers, hospitals and medical facilities implementing sustainability initiatives such as energy efficiency improvements, waste reduction, green building design and environmentally responsible practices.

Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.

Summary (250 words max)	In no more than 250 words, explain why your organisation deserves to win this award.
Innovative Sustainable Practices	Describe the sustainability initiatives implemented within your organisation. Focus on what has been introduced and how it has improved operations.
Adaptation and Resilience	Show how your organisation is adapting to climate-related challenges in healthcare delivery. This may include managing risks such as extreme weather, public health impacts or service continuity.
Community Engagement	Outline how your organisation engages with patients, staff or the wider community on sustainability and climate-related issues. Include any awareness, education or outreach initiatives.
Measurable Impact and Outcomes	Demonstrate the results of your initiatives. This should include measurable improvements such as reduced emissions, cost savings, operational efficiencies or improved health outcomes. Focus on clear, evidenced results rather than intended benefits.

Scoring (100 Points Total)

- Innovative Sustainable Practices (25 Points)
- Adaptation and Resilience (20 Points)
- Community Engagement (15 Points)
- Measurable Impact and Outcomes (40 Points)

Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
