This award will be judged based on an organisation's commitment to integrating climate, environmental and sustainability topics into its curriculum, course delivery and wider organisational activity.

Please note your entry should be a maximum of 2,500 words.

Summary (250 words max)	In no more than 250 words, explain why your organisation deserves to win this award.
Curriculum Integration	Describe how climate, environmental and sustainability topics have been incorporated into your curriculum. This should include new or updated courses, modules or programmes and their relevance to learners.
Innovation in Teaching and Learning	Explain how these topics are delivered in practice. This should include teaching methods, student engagement and any innovative approaches used to improve understanding and participation.
Community Engagement and Outreach	Outline your organisation's efforts to engage with communities, partners or stakeholders on climate and sustainability topics. Include any outreach programmes or initiatives delivered beyond the classroom.
Leadership and Advocacy	Demonstrate your organisation's role in promoting climate and sustainability topics internally and externally. This may include policies, initiatives or leadership activities.
Impact and Measurable Outcomes	Show the results of your initiatives. This should include measurable improvements in engagement, learning outcomes or wider impact, with evidence of progress over time.

Scoring (100 Points Total)

- Curriculum Integration: 25
- Innovation in Teaching and Learning: 20
- Community Engagement and Outreach: 15
- Leadership and Advocacy: 10
- Impact and Measurable Outcomes: 30

Tips for a Successful Entry

- Answer each section clearly using the headings provided. Marks will be based on the evidence you include.
- Focus on what you did and the results it delivered.
- Include data where possible and avoid general statements.
- Only the first 2,500 words of your entry will be assessed.
- Use headings, short paragraphs and simple structure to make your application easy to follow.
- There is a 10MB limit per file for supporting documents.
