Summary	In no more than 250 words, explain why your consultancy deserves to win this award.
Technical Expertise and Consultancy Delivery	Demonstrate your consultancy's engineering expertise through the projects, advisory services or technical solutions you deliver. Include examples of technical complexity, multidisciplinary coordination or specialist capability where relevant.
Sustainable Engineering and Environmental Integration	How does your consultancy incorporate sustainability, environmental performance and long-term resilience into engineering solutions, planning or project delivery?
Engineering Challenges and Problem Solving	Provide examples of technical or environmental challenges your consultancy has addressed and the engineering solutions developed to achieve successful outcomes.
Collaboration and Client Engagement	How does your consultancy work with clients, regulators, contractors, planners or project teams to support successful delivery and long-term outcomes?
Industry Impact and Project Outcomes	Provide evidence of successful project outcomes, measurable environmental impact, client results or wider contribution to the engineering sector.
