

HUNTER/ EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Beginner Walk/Trot: Open to beginner riders who have not shown higher than crossrails or 18" fences.

13 & Under Walk/Trot: Open to horses/ponies and riders 13 years and under. Intended for inexperienced riders.

14 & Over Walk/Trot: Open to horses/ponies and riders 14 years and older. Intended for inexperienced riders.

Ground Rails Equitation: Open to beginner riders. Not open to riders showing above joggers. Courses are once around. Walk/Trot division.

Joggers Equitation: Open to beginner riders in their first years of showing. Courses are once around. Walk/Trot division. No Flower boxes.

Crossrail Equitation & Hunter: Open to novice riders. Jump height at 18" Crossrail. Trotting is allowed. W/T/C.

Mini Hunter & Equitation: Open to all horses and ponies and riders. Mini Hunter may cross enter Beginner classes (if eligible) and Open Stirrups crossrail. Simple changes are acceptable. Fence height 18".

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Fence height 2'.

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to Junior and Amateur riders ages 13 years and older on horses or ponies, in the rider's first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Fence height 2'3"

Long Stirrup Equitation: Open to qualified Long Stirrup Riders. Fence height 2'3".

Silver Stirrup Hunter: Open to adult amateur riders, 35 years of age and older, who have not shown in classes with fence heights 2'6" or higher in the past three (3) years. Fence height at 2', no oxers.

Schooling Pony (2' 2'3 2'6): 2' or 2'3 or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainer's discretion. Open to Junior riders only.

Schooling Hunter 2': Open to all horses and ponies and riders. Intended for beginner rider and/or green horse that has never jumped over 2' in competition.

Young 7yr Hunter: Open to young hunter age 7yr or younger. Fences height 2'3.

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to any registered Thoroughbred, ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professional riders. Fence height at either 2'3 or 2'6.

HUNTER/ EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Pre-Children's Hunter: Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Rider/Horse combinations may not cross over into Children's Hunter. Fence height 2'6".

Pre-Adult Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Rider/Horse combinations may not cross over into Adult Hunter. Fence height 2'6".

Open Stirrup Divisions: Open to all horses/ponies and rider combinations. Divisions offered at 2'6 and crossrails.

Modified Hunter: Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9".

Equitation Challegne: Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur GHJA members on horses or ponies. To be judged at a walk, trot, and canter. Competitors will be asked to perform at least two of the following USEF tests chosen by the Judge: #2- Halt (4 to 6 seconds) or Halt and Back; #10- Change leads on a line demonstrating a simple or flying change of lead; #13- Ride without stirrups; #15- Canter on the counter lead (Note: no more than twelve horses may counter canter at one time); #19- Perform basic dressage movements. Judges may choose from shoulder in, shoulder out, haunches in, haunches out, leg yield, and half pass; #20- Hand gallop. Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated.

JUMPER CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

All jumper classes will be held to USEF TABLE IV SECTION 1 or TABLE IV SECTION 2b Optimum Time (OT). Time Allowed (TA) will be posted on the course at the start of the active show day. Optimum time will be considered 4 seconds less than the posted Time Allowed. Ties in faults will be determined by the horse with the closet time to the Optimum Time (over or under).

Rules & Safety

- An approved ASTM helmet MUST always be worn when mounted.
No Exceptions.
- All horses are required to have proof of current negative Coggins at check-in.
- All Entry Forms must be signed by an adult: competitor, parent, and/or trainer as designated. Email, address, and contact cell number must be included.
- Formal show attire is not required. However, proper attire is required in all classes except warm-ups, when chaps or other non-standard attire may be worn. Martingales are not permitted in flat classes. Running martingales are allowed in the Jumper Ring.
- Steele Stirrups LLC, their employees and officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons, horses, or any property while at the show. Nor will they be responsible for any personal articles lost, stolen, or destroyed.
- Schooling over Show Fences is permitted only during the designated time, Friday from 12:00 – 5:00 p.m.
- Horses and ponies may enter no more than 7 over-fences classes in a single show day, no more than 5 of which may be jumper classes. All "special" hunter and jumper classes, including warm-ups and medals count toward the total limit of seven O/F classes per day.
- Back numbers must be worn where visible during schooling. Schooling will be open the day before the event show days. All show rings will be open during the specified time set by show management. Participants are required to check in with a ring attendant before entering the ring.
- We strive to provide a safe and friendly event. To help ensure this we ask that all attendees be polite and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Show Management reserves the right to excuse any attendees who show any unwanted behavior and/or demonstrate any safety violations that may cause harm not only to themselves but others. Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy toward a judge, show official, show staff or horse park staff member on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry, and all fees will be forfeited.

- In case of inclement weather, updates will be sent out via our Facebook Page: www.facebook.com/steelestirrupsllc or email.
- While shows are not GHJA recognized, Steele Stirrups follows the GHJA rules and regulations for all shows. This includes, but is not limited to, management restrictions, show procedures, equine tack restrictions, horse/pony qualifications, and rider qualifications. <http://www.ghja.org/rules.html>. Questions not covered by GHJA rules will be decided by show management and their decisions will be final.
- Lunging is permitted only in designated areas and back numbers must be visible.
- A 3-minute gate call may be put into effect at any time upon announcement. Flat Classes will not be held for trainer conflicts. Please check with gate keepers often & advise of possible conflicts.
- All dogs must be on a leash no more than 6 feet long, or otherwise contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines.
- Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate motorized vehicles of any kind including (but not limited to) golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds.
- Poling and offsets are forbidden anywhere on the show grounds.
- The Class Schedule may be changed for the betterment of the show. Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge should a legitimate need arise.
- Parents or guardians shall hold management, staff & officials harmless for any injury to minor show participants, staff, or spectators.
- Prizes and Awards Ribbons will be awarded first through sixth place. Championship and Reserve Champion ribbons and awards (as applicable) will be awarded for hunter divisions with at least two over fences and an under saddle class with at least three competitors completing classes.
