6. Part of your welcome pack will be a name badge you are to wear at all times during the camp, including your medical conditions and allergies. We also have a medical doctor and snake expert as part of our team.

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Legal consent:

As parent/guardian, I am sending the child in my care, to take part in the programmes and activities at the Boys2Men Camp, hosted at Apostle Battery Campsite, Llandudno, subject to the following conditions:

ALL SUCH CLAIMS ARE WAIVED BY YOU AS A PARENT.**

2. You, as parent/guardian, understand and agree that your child/the children in your care:

2.1. Are hereby permitted to attend the camp and participate in all activities at the camp, including transport to and from the camp by the camp leaders and facilitators;

2.2. will obey all legal and fair instructions from the camp facilitators, leaders and any other church or campsite staff;

2.3. you may be contacted to collect your child if such child/children fail or refuses to cooperate or disobey camp rules or reasonable instructions given to them or endanger others at the camp;

2.4. are not allergic to any food, medicine or any other things, and all medical conditions have been disclosed to us in writing above;

2.5. may receive medical attention if needed and if neither of the parents/guardians can be contacted, and you as parent/legal guardian hereby give permission for such emergency medical treatment to be given to your child/ren, deemed necessary by a licensed medical practitioner, and agree to be liable for any associated costs;

2.6. may be included in photos and/or videos taken at the camp, and such photos and videos may be shared on social media and used in future marketing endeavours for the camp.

3. Although you agree and understand that every care is taken to ensure the safety of your child/the children in your care, you declare that you are aware that attendance at the camp (including participation in transportation and activities) is at their own risk.

4. All persons (including their parents/guardians and caretakers) registering for the camp and/or participating in the camp agree and understand that they do so subject to these terms and conditions, which they accept upon registering for the Event and/or entering the camp or using any of the transport or camp facilities, and they further agree to abide by the rules and conditions of access and use of the property stipulated by the operators and their principals, from time to time.

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
