Strong STEAM Curriculum and Academic Pathways

Bishop Montgomery's Academic Pathways give students the opportunity to select a specific area of study in addition to the outstanding college preparatory curriculum provided. In our Academic Pathways, students are exposed to advanced level coursework and clubs designed to provide hands-on and project-based experiences.

The Sports Medicine Pathway

The program is designed for students who have an interest in athletic training, kinesiology, nutrition, orthopaedics, physical therapy or any sports-medicine related field. Students in this pathway gain hands-on experience in injury evaluation and prevention, rehabilitation, and first aid. Students in this pathway are required to have volunteer hours either with our Athletic Trainer or at an off-campus approved facility.

The Arts, Media & Entertainment Pathway

It is designed for students who have a passion for creative expression, communication, and storytelling. Within this pathway, students will have the opportunity to choose between two tracks: Design, Visual & Media Arts or Performing Arts.

The Engineering Pathway

The program has partnered with Project Lead the Way to help take our students' learning into the 21st century and beyond. We house a newly renovated STEAM Center that includes a maker space with five 3D printers, a robotics lab and practice arena, and enough tools and equipment necessary to make any builds a reality. We are also excited to bring an aerospace engineering course that will allow students to utilize a wind tunnel and test their piloting skills on flight simulators.





Social Studies Pathways

The Legal Pathway

Designed for students who have a passion for research, debate, public speaking and writing. In addition to their academic course, students may be required to actively participate in either the Speech & Debate Club or Mock Trial Club throughout their four years.

The Social Justice & Advocacy Pathway

Designed for students who have a passion for promoting equity and inclusion in society. Students will explore social justice concepts, historical contexts and current issues pertaining to social justice. In addition to their academic courses, students will be required to actively participate - for a minimum of 3 years - in either Concordia Club, Green Team, Key Club or the Marine Conservation Club.

Faculty Team and Student Outcomes

- Bishop's 48 full-time faculty members, all hold professional degrees. 84% of faculty have been at BMHS for 5 years or more and 29% of faculty are alumni.

State-Of-The-Art Anatomage Table

Bishop Montgomery is one of just a handful of high schools in the world to have an Anatomage Table. The tool is often found at elite four-year universities.

Advanced Technology

- The Anatomage Table is one of the most technologically-advanced anatomy visualization systems in the world.
- A growing number of publications show the tool leads to improved test scores, more efficient class and lab sessions, and higher student university acceptances

The Anatomage Table is a powerful education tool, giving students the opportunity to:

- Dissect human and animal cadavers reconstructed in precise 3D
- View MRI and CT scans
- Gain a more comprehensive understanding of anatomy, pathology, and even surgical planning.
- And much more

The Anatomage table is currently used in many classes including Health, Biology/Honors Biology, Anatomy and Physiology/Honors Anatomy and Physiology, and Sports Medicine, but is also accessible to students of all grade levels.

Experienced Music Director

The music program is run by Eric Hankey, a highly experienced music educator. Eric has been teaching for 24 years and has been with Bishop Montgomery for 9 years. He has degrees in trombone performance and music education from Ithaca College and the University of Southern California (#22). Mr. Eric Hankey was nominated in 2018 to the Music Educator Award presented by the Recording Academy and the Grammy Museum. This award was established to recognize current educators who have made a significant contribution to the field of music education.

World Travelers

Bishop Montgomery's music groups frequently travel around the world. Every year, the program arranges a Spring Break trip in which students perform at various venues for large audiences. In the past, students have attended many festivals in southern California, the Bay Area, and Arizona, and have also traveled to Washington, D.C., Japan, England and Italy.





Architecture—Construction—Engineering

The ACE Mentorship Program collaborates with California business Del Amo Construction, where students interested in the fields of architecture and engineering receive mentorship and real-world learning experiences.

Del Amo Construction

Established in 1968, Del Amo is a renowned construction company in California and has worked on many successful, award-winning construction projects, including work at the CalTech Graduate Aerospace Laboratories, at the USC Seeley G. Mudd Lab and much more.

Program Details

The program divides students into several groups, guided by Del Amo architects as tutors. Students complete corresponding engineering tasks to further their learning.

The program consists of 15 two-hour courses each school year, which students take after school. Students also spend time shadowing their mentor on the construction site during the holidays.

Courses include:

- CAD: Engineering and Architecture Model Drawing Software
- Simple Drawings and Structural Bearing Analysis
- Image Analysis Data
- Analysis and Calculations of Roadway Data





eSports League

Bishop Montgomery is a member of the California Interscholastic Federation's E-League, and is one of the few schools in the state of California to offer an eSports League as an official school sport. The team competes against other schools in Southern California and across the nation year-round.

Benefits of the Program

eSports provides additional avenues for students to reap the benefits of team sports that include dedication, perseverance, and teamwork. The eSports teams also provides opportunities for students to hone strategic thinking, collaboration, and problemsolving skills, as well as provide exposure to potential career pathways and even possible college scholarships.

- 2nd place finish in the Spring 2020 CIF eSports California Cup tournament: won over \$3,000 worth of equipment and prizes

Homestay

At Bishop Montgomery, international students who choose to live in Homestay not only get a great education, they also find loving homes and create lasting relationships with their host families.

Homestay family selection process

Safety is always the #1 priority for our students. All host families undergo a rigorous application and screening process to ensure they are a good candidate to host. This includes:

- A comprehensive application
- Background check for every adult in the home
- An interview
- An in-person home check by an international staff team member
- Matching to student interest forms to ensure a good fit for both student and host (completed after acceptance into program)











Life in a Homestay

- Students live in safe, comfortable homestays in close proximity to the school
- Students have comfortable bedrooms, including a dresser, bed, desk and closet
- Host families and students are paired through methodical matching process
- Regular acculturation activities are offered through both the host family and the school
- Our international team is in constant communication with families, including receiving monthly reports
- 24/7 team is available for emergency assistance or urgent issues
- The host family offers a full-time English language environment
- Hosts provide transportation to and from the school every day
- Family provides healthy meals every day
