

Project Lead the Way Engineering Program

Overview

Students have the opportunity to take a fouryear engineering program, which follows a hands-on, real world approach to learning. Throughout the courses, students learn and apply the design process, acquire teamwork and communication skills and learn to think critically.

Distinguished School

Justin-Siena has also been recognized as a Project Lead The Way Distinguished School for displaying exemplary results. This high honor is given to students who have demonstrated high student engagement and achievement in their Project Lead The Way Programs

Engineering Courses

All courses are approved by the University of California as an interdisciplinary elective

Principles of Engineering:

Students investigate engineering and high-tech careers and develop an understanding of concepts including mechanisms, energy, statics, materials and kinematics.

Civil Engineering and Architecture:

The course focuses on long-term projects that involve the development of property sites. Students design and development their own property, using hands-on activities, 3D software and more.

AP Computer Science Principles:

Students use Python, Scratch, HTML, Java Script, CS, SQL and PHP to develop advanced computer skills.

Robotics

Overview

Justin-Siena offers 3 Robotics Teams in the FIRST® Tech Challenge Robotics League. FIRST is a robotics competition where students are guided by adult coaches and mentors. They develop STEM skills and practice engineering principles, all while realizing the value of hard work, innovation, teamwork, and idea sharing.

Business Skills

In addition to building on their engineering skills, each robotics team is exposed to real-world business skills. Every team must raise funds, design, and market their team brand, as well as engage in community outreach for which they can win awards. Participants have access to tens of millions of dollars in college scholarships.

Success and Impact

Students in the Robotics league have gone on to receive scholarships and acceptances into prestigious universities, including Princeton University (#1), Amherst College (#2 Liberal Arts), and Georgia Tech (#29).

Due to their participation in Robotics, more than 86% of students reported having more interest in doing well in school and 87% had more interest in attending college.





Mock Trial

Overview

Justin-Siena offers a highly-competitive Mock Trial team. Mock Trial is a nationwide activity in which each school has the same set of facts and law with which to work. Teams then present a fully realized trial in a real court before a real judge. Each school has a prosecution and defense team, which alternate in weekly trials.

Justin-Siena's Mock Trial team is ranked #19 in the entire state of California. The team has won the Napa County competition for the past 6 years in a row, where they compete against teams from 35 other counties.

Advantages of the Program

The Mock Trial program was created to help students acquire a working knowledge of the U.S. judicial system, develop analytical abilities and communication skills, and gain an understanding of their obligations and responsibilities as participating members of society.

Students involved in Justin-Siena's Mock Trial team have gone on to study at prestigious U.S. universities, including Columbia University and Stanford University.

Alondra (Justin-Siena Class of 2017, Stanford University Class of 2021) credits Mock Trial for her personal development during high school, saying "Not only did I learn about law, I became a more confident and inspired person."






Safety Features Include:


- Door cameras in the apartments (not bedrooms)
