



Saint John's has a robust engineering program through the internationally-renown Project Lead the Way Program. The program includes 5 courses, with successful students being eligible for college credit.


Students may receive three (3) college credits from the Rochester Institute of Technology upon completion of each course's required End of Course exam (EoC) and scores achieved.

Homestay

At St. John's High School, international students live in warm and welcoming Homestays. They not only get a great education, they also find loving homes and create lasting relationships with their host families.

Homestay family selection process

Safety is always the **#1 priority** for our students. All host families undergo a rigorous application and screening process to ensure they are a good candidate to host. This includes:

- A comprehensive application
- Background check for every adult in the home
- An interview
- An in-person home check by an international staff team member
- Matching to student interest forms to ensure a good fit for both student and host (completed after acceptance into program)











Life in a Homestay

- Students live in safe, comfortable homestays in close proximity to the school
- Students have comfortable bedrooms, including a dresser, bed, desk and closet
- Host families and students are paired through methodical matching process
- Regular acculturation activities are offered through both the host family and the school
- Our international team is in constant communication with families, including receiving monthly reports
- 24/7 team is available for emergency assistance or urgent issues
- The host family offers a full-time English language environment
- Hosts provide transportation to and from the school every day
- Family provides healthy meals every day
